History AutoCAD has been in continuous development since it was first released in 1982. It was originally developed by the company-owned Graphic Dimensions division of the Autodesk division of Colorado-based SRS Inc, with early releases written in Basic on an Apple II, then later versions in BASIC, Fortran and C. In 1988, AutoCAD was sold to Autodesk Inc and was redesigned by Autodesk's Media and Entertainment division, primarily for high-end video-game developers. Autodesk also marketed it to the architectural and engineering communities, and in 2004, it was rebranded as AutoCAD LT, to reflect its wider-use profile. AutoCAD History Before 1982 the industry was dominated by two tools - AutoCAD and IDMS, made by V&V (later Unify Systems), who in turn got AutoCAD from Andrew "Andy" Johns in 1980. Johns worked for the consulting firm of Wright & Fisher (a division of the Crowther & Moring Co, now part of Rockwell International). Because the company was so large, Wright & Fisher could not service all of its client's individual requirements through a single channel. Johns was one of the few technical people in the firm. Johns was paid handsomely for his technical work and, in the spirit of entrepreneurship, started his own company, Andy Johns' Computer Graphics. Johns developed a new system, which he called IDMS (Integrated Design Management System) for Wright & Fisher, which allowed their designers to use the AutoCAD drawings they created for the auto and aircraft industries, and be able to place, move, resize, rotate, show or hide the drawing. This system became very popular for small- to medium-sized businesses that needed very basic CAD, which was called "cheap" CAD back then. The first version of AutoCAD was released in late 1982, and by the time it came out, Autodesk had lost its consulting contracts and the industry was going through a period of consolidation. The price of AutoCAD was about \$4,000, which compared favorably to previous systems costing around \$1,000 to \$3,000. The first release of AutoCAD was designed to run on a very basic system, the Apple II, with an internal graphics chip. At this point, AutoCAD was being used by only a few businesses. The price of AutoCAD was too expensive to be used as the primary
